Northside College Preparatory High School needs your help. As we embark on another academic year, it is paramount that we raise essential funds for our students to receive the highest level of education, support, and enrichment.

Driven by that goal, Friends of Northside will host its spring benefit - "Taste of Northside: A Feast and Fundraiser for Northside College Prep" - on March 13, 2020, at DANK Haus German American Cultural Center. Last year's benefit at that venue was an unprecedented success. Our goal is to build on that momentum by raising \$150,000.

Northside is an ethnically and socio-economically diverse selective-enrollment CPS high school comprised of students from throughout Chicago. Northside consistently ranks as one of the best high schools in the state of Illinois and nationwide, but we cannot maintain that status without constantly improving. The status quo is not enough, and we need our community's help-individuals and businesses alike-to help pave our path forward.

Funds raised will be used for critical operational needs that our CPS budget doesn't cover, including, but not limited to: a social worker to provide emotional support to our students; an extra security guard for after school hours so our students can study and socialize in a safe, onsite environment; college-counseling support; fine arts programming; athletics; and technology.
